Action Step	Description	Evidence of Completion
1.17	Data chats on Early Warning Indicators	Data chat agendas Data chats regularly occur, and attention given to subgroup populations
1.2	Monitor students for course failures and concordant scores	Number of students participating Students are placed into Edgenuity as identified. Teachers are monitored for high failure rate.
1.19	Ensure African American students who have not met course requirements for graduation are participating in "in- school" credit recovery classes to recover failed core courses and raise grade point averages to meet graduation requirements	Credit recovery course rosters Teachers monitor students closely for progress. The progress has been slow for 4 th quarter.

1.15	Each secondary principal will create an African American Student Council to gather feedback on the impact of support.	Membership rosters African American Student Council has been formed. First virtual meeting occur before the end of the 4 th quarter.
