

VBHS's Monitoring of At-Risk Minority Students

– 1.18 Monitor African American students who are not on track to graduate (Data include early warning indicators (K-12), credits earned, core course failures, FSA 10th Grade ELA results and FSA ALG 1 EOC results) and provide an opportunity to participate in after school and summer extended learning opportunities (ELO). Employ recruitment and targeted resource strategies, including partnering with the community, to increase attendance for African American students in all extended learning programs.

- Constant community outreach, e.g. Guidance provided an information booth at the Gifford Community Center to answer any questions or concerns as part of the community outreach plan.
- PERT math Tutoring provided in days leading up to Algebra I EOC concordant testing.
- Tribe Tutoring provided after school.
- After school Credit Recovery help on Thursdays with Transportation provided.
- Summer Credit Recovery courses provided with meals and transportation.
