On January 22nd, for K and 3 and on February 5th, for 1, 2, 4, and 5, we will have our data chats where we will be looking at students' data from Tier 2/Tier 3 instruction.

The purpose of the data chat is to look at the progress monitoring data, unit/weekly assessments, and Iready on line instruction to see if our tiered intervention instruction is helping to move the student in a positive direction or are adjustments needed.

(Be sure to pay attention to any student who has been previously retained)

We have sent a link to the one drive document that will need to be completed prior to the meeting. In the one drive document, you will find a tab for Tier 2 and Tier 3 along with the teacher's name that teaches the intervention.

Please list the students by intervention teacher. Some of the information will need to be filled in by the homeroom teacher and other parts by the intervention teacher. Your Tier 3 students will be listed in both places. You can cut and paste most of the information from one tab to the next.

You will document the progress monitoring data points, bring copies of your graphs, note whether you feel the progress is positive, flat or declining and then note if you would like to continue the current intervention, look at further/different interventions, or dismiss interventions based on the student performance data.
