1.19 Ensure African American students who have not met course requirements for graduation are participating in "in- school" credit recovery classes to recover failed core courses and raise grade point averages to meet graduation requirements.

Narrative

Counselors are meeting with students and contacting home daily for students who must meet graduation requirements. We must wait for grades to post on May 29 to determine how many students will need emergency recovery. Counselors and grad coach are contacting students through FOCUS, by phone, and social media to provide encouragement to complete courses.
