- 1. Discussed follow up with students who have received one or more "F" grades in the fourth quarter.
 - 30% of the African American students currently have an "F" in one or more courses
 - Teachers have been provided with guidelines to monitor grades
 - Additional faculty meetings will have teachers look at their students for completion of work
 - Teachers with a large number of "F"s have been talked with individually
- 2. Dual Enrollment opportunities
 - The Indian River State College does not require the PERT for Dual Enrollment until January 2021.
 - Students need to be identified who have a 3.0 (particularly those without acceleration courses thus far) to take the Dual Enrollment courses.
 - African American students who would benefit should receive a direct invitation to participate in the Dual Enrollment.
 - Students may use the district computers and hot spots for dual enrollment courses.
- 3. Currently it is reported the graduation rate is 87%. Students must continue to be monitored and given support to complete credit recovery courses.
 - The school must work to ensure all students at risk of not graduating due to course failure makes up the identified courses.
