26/73 students Meeting Criteria for Promotion Review by Committee (Early Warning Indicators: Attendance, Academic Data below grade level expectations, Previous Retentions/PMPs)

10/26: Black 38% 6/26: Hispanic 23% 10/26: White 38%

7/26: Retained in 1st Grade 19/26: Promoted with a Progress Monitoring Plan

Students Retained in 1st Grade:

3/7: Black 43% 0/7: Hispanic 0% 4/7: White 57%
