Indian River Charter High School

Guidance Counselors at the school complete regular graduation checks with students. Guidance Counselors coordinate efforts with families for students who have not passed ELA Assessments to achieve concordant scores on alternative exams. Families are contacted and guided through the process of signing up for these exams. Teachers of intensive courses also call home to coordinate students signing up for alternative exams.

All students meet with their Homebase teacher once per month to go over grades, issues, goals, and life in general. Homebase teachers help ensure that students are on track for graduation. In this way, all students at the school are monitored and meet one-on-one with a teacher. An example of a form that students complete during this meeting is copy/pasted below.
