Develop a training for school counselors to facilitate conversations with at-risk students to review options for graduation, meet graduation requirements and develop individual plans for students. Principals will meet with school counselors to review and monitor implementation of the plan.

Narrative

School counselors have been directed by the Principal to make earnest attempts in contacting all students which included all African-American students who are considered “at-risk” of not graduating with their cohort. School counselors have documented their individualized plans for each of their assigned students on MS Excel and submitting their individual documented reports directly to the School Principal on a weekly basis.

Data

In the month of May, 39 African-American students have been contacted by their School counselors and reported by MS Excel.

Action Plan

The School Principal will continue monitoring each School Counselors progress and will continue to meet with them as a team in conjunction with the SRHS Administrative Team on a biweekly basis to discuss the African-American Achievement Plan.
