

1.25- Principals will schedule, plan and coordinate parent meetings with African American students who require intensive support to graduate.

Narrative

The Principal of Sebastian River High School issued a directive for all School counselors to document parental contacts of African-American students who are at-risk of not graduating. In the month of April, School counselors have made weekly contacts with 15 African-American seniors who are at risk of not graduating.

Data

- 45 out of 60 Black students on track to graduate
- 5 African-American students below a 2.0 GPA
- 9 African-American students are making up failed courses
- 1 African-American student is below 21 credits
- 11 African-American students are under the 18-credit option plan

Action Plan

All School counselors will continue to report the graduation status of all African-Americans who are atrisk of not graduating directly to the Principal by Friday of each week. Each School counselor will document on a Microsoft spreadsheet of each African-American student and parent they contacted by Friday of each week until graduation day.
