1. Have a scaffolded criterion for earning awards:

    - i. General Education students had to increase a full level

2. Student of the Month recognition is not based on academics, but our PBIS expectations.
3. Student of the Month recognition is put out for a vote by ALL grade level teacher to have input.
4. Student of the Month recognition is forwarded to Admin for final approval (student repeats is not permitted)
5. Student are recognized for participation in all Extended Learning Opportunities and Clubs.
