Rosewood Teachers and Staff are expected to recognize all students for their academic successes. When recognition ceremonies are held, staff members and grade levels are required to report the number of students receiving recognitions by award and ethnicity to administration prior to the ceremony to ensure that there is an equitable representation of students.

End of year awards ceremonies:

May 2020 Awards - some revisions due to online learning.

(This year's awards will look different due to online learning. We have limited awards going home in most grade groups due to current circumstances.)

Every student receives at least one award or end of the year celebration type of recognition.

Kindergarten - Character awards – all students will get one.

First grade - End of year 'memories' video – all students will get one.

Second grade – Fifth grade – they will be submitting their list of awards next week once grades are completed.

❖ Break down by subgroup will be added once all grades are entered next week (May 28th) and awards are completed. This will be added to the district survey.

We do shout – outs throughout the year as students do well in reading, character, efforts and behaviors. Teachers send names throughout the year and we do a shout out on the morning announcements. This is not tracked at this time. We will begin to track these for next school year. We have been continuing to share shout outs through our online announcements daily.

Typically:

Grades K-1:

Teachers give awards for effort, kindness, and some fun awards to recognize personality and growth, every student gets an award/recognition.

Grades 2nd -4th:

Students earn the following awards: A Honor Roll, A/B Honor Roll, Citizenship, Outstanding Effort, and Character Awards

Grade 5:

Below is the awards ceremony for our 5th grade celebration, along with an explanation of each award.

Explanation of Awards

Each teacher will read the names of their students who received each award. Students, please stand when your name is read and remain standing until all student names from your class have been read. Parents and friends, please hold your applause until all names from each class have been read.

A-B Average Students that earned an A/B average for the year in all subject areas.

A Average- Students that earned an A Average for the year in all subject areas.

Panther Pride- This award is a special award just for two Rosewood Students in each class. These students were chosen by their classmates as having the best qualities of friendship and kindness throughout the school year. These students

have exceeded the Citizenship Award and have exemplified the values of Rosewood. They are deserving of our "Panther Pride".

Citizenship- The top ten students from each class that exemplify the six pillars of character from the Character Counts! Program: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship.

Outstanding Effort- This award is chosen by the teachers. These are students who showed outstanding effort in different subjects throughout the year.

Perfect Attendance-Students who have received perfect attendance for their fifth grade year.

Outstanding Academic Achievement – This silver award is given to students who made significant gains in subject areas. Presidential Award.

Outstanding Academic Excellence (gold)- This gold award is given to students who earned a straight A average in all subject areas in fifth grade AND scored a level 5 on the FSA in math or reading or earned an A average in all subjects for their fourth grade year. This special certificate includes a pin of excellence. Presidential award.
