- What is going well with behavior?
 - Frequent flyer list is small(ish)
 - Some improvements with tier 3 kiddos
 - o PBIS
 - Fewer students being sent home (able to be de-escalated)
- What are our needs?
 - Tier 1: Maurette (modeling), Bakhuizen (modeling, coaching/feedback), Wentz (coaching/feedback)
 - Tier 2/3 plans followed with fidelity
 - o PBIS plans tightened up in some rooms
 - Crosley not calling SRO
 - Pelican Press behavioral reminders
 - Calls for assistance (safety emergencies and breaks for tier 3 students)
 - CIR versus ODR
 - Teacher-initiated breaks when needed
 - O'Shea meet with each teacher who has a student on a plan to review and sign off on it
 - Blidgen models SEL lesson in all K-2 classrooms (Emotional ABCs, Second Step, Mindset, Sanford Harmony)
 - Shared Folder for all SEL lessons Moree
 - Moree and O'Shea meet with special area teachers (Thursday collaborative planning?)

 - De-escalation: push in to classroom when possible, workrooms
 - Break: reward for doing their work/following expectations

- EBD Unit (consistent behavior and lesson plans, compliance training)
