



Began researching resources for best practices when implementing a peer to peer mentoring program. Will continue to research and begin developing guidelines and tools for leadership team to implement a peer mentor program next school year. Will work with school guidance counselor to identify mentors, inform parents of both 'buddies' in the peer groups, and set up expectations and opportunities for meetings, supports and activities. Also plan how the program will be evaluated and what data will be tracked to determine effectiveness of program. Plans will be shared with stakeholders through SAC, PTA, teacher newsletters, school newsletter and school website/facebook page.
