Each student was reviewed, regardless of their race to see what was needed to bridge the gaps of learning. When a Tier 2 or Tier 3 intervention is created, it will be progress monitored and then data is reviewed to discuss progress. K-3 Intervention teacher is working with students who are in the bottom quartile and are not scheduled with a reading endorsed teacher.

Students who are in Option 2 (Virtual) and Option 3 (Transitional) are working with support facilitators, assigned teachers, K-3 intervention teacher, and school counselor to support academic achievement and learning. Some families are being encouraged to return to Option 1 for face-to-face instruction based on performance through online platforms.
