
Of the 56 students who have completed the Reading Diagnostic, 38/56 (68%) of students are at least one grade level below as evidenced by the Fall Iready Reading Diagnostic. Qualified students will be receiving targeted reading interventions by their classroom teacher daily. Principal and AP will conduct data chats and monitor schoolbased action plans which includes adjustments to instructional support based on student progress

Results of Action Taken: In process

Reflection:

The goal is for all Kindergarten students to progress and build the pre kindergarten skills that are not present at this time. Teachers will build on those skills throughout the school day to ensure progression towards grade level.

Monitoring of those skills will take place bi weekly.



Of the 56 students who are not kindergarten ready, 7 (13%) are African American.
