

### MATH REALITY

School-wide learning gains in Mathematics decreased from 63% to 55% and learning gains for students in the Lowest 25th Percentile decreased from 71% to 41%.

### WHAT'S NEEDED IN MATH

### READING REALITY

ELA proficiency decreased from 59% to 53 which is 5 percentage points below the district. The percentage of the bottom 25th percentile that made learning gains decreased from 61% down to 49%


