1.6 Indian River Charter High School offers extended learning opportunities for remediation and enrichment at the school as well as parent workshops and activities at school.

Explanation of Evidence:

Dr. Adams, the Artistic/Assistant Director at the school is spearheading a peer tutoring program at the school this year. Students with mutual independent study time meet weekly for tutoring. The program will begin in the second quarter of the 2020-2021 school year. The Assistant Director will run a report for any African American student failing one or more courses, and those students will have the option to participate in tutoring. A school day at IRCHS runs from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM. Students have built-in independent study time throughout the school day, so tutoring is scheduled during the school day and does not need to take place after school. All students participate in the school's integrated, thematic curriculum and Semester VAPA shows. Students learn about different eras from history through the lens of the core disciplines. Students work on projects throughout the semester and present them at a show, which is open to the public. Projects can be educational displays, interactive activities, art projects, computer programs, and more. Working on and presenting projects at VAPA shows provides students with opportunities for enrichment after school. Some pictures of students participating in this program have been uploaded (VAPA SP 1, 3, 23, 38, 48, 57, 58). IRCHS hosts 'Senior Parent Nights' twice a year to ensure that parents are educated regarding graduation pathways, opportunities for scholarships, and application procedures for colleges. These nights were advertised via email, the school website, and social media (Senior Parent Meeting Email).

Results of Action Taken:

Parents of Seniors had the opportunity to watch a video created by Senior Seminar teachers (Senior Parent Meeting Video). Topics covered in the video were: filling out a FAFSA, connecting with scholarship resources, dual enrollment opportunities, local state college opportunities, certificate programs, and more.

Reflection:

The school seeks to create more opportunities for parent education in the future, including workshops on the subject of the influence of attendance on academic performance, student social media use, and mental health awareness.
