The included documentation shows the attendance roster from a recent Tuesday afternoon afterschool tutoring session. SRHS provides free two-hour afterschool tutoring every Tuesday and Thursday until 4:15 p.m. along with bus transportation if needed. Tutoring is available in the four core subject areas and Spanish. The W-108 computer lab is also available for students who need to do Edgenuity course recovery during that time. Also included is a snapshot from our daily announcements regarding tutoring. Announcements are done over the PA each morning and then posted to the SRHS website for parents.

**Results of Action
Taken:**

African American students are able to meet with subject area specific teachers in the core areas in individual or small group settings.

Reflection:

SRHS will continue to offer free tutoring afterschool and promote it. Counselors and teachers will specifically promote it to their African American students who may be struggling or want enrichment in their classes. Our CTE teachers will provide afterschool prep sessions ahead of certification exam dates as well.
