1.11 Develop a process to identify the current needs and supports for equitable participation in extracurricular activities (e.g., cheerleading, lacrosse, soccer and orchestra).

Explanation of Evidence:

Indian River Charter High School does not offer competitive sports. Instead, we focus on the Visual and Performing Arts. Many visual and performing arts courses are offered at the school, and all offer opportunities for participation in after school activities. Data has been uploaded which shows 68% African American participation in these courses (A.A. Students in VAPA Courses). In addition, the school requires that all students participate in the VAPA show, a government meeting, a cultural event, and earn ten volunteer hours each semester. The school ensures that all students have opportunities to fulfill this obligation, with teachers and staff working outside of regular school hours to coordinate and supervise events. Evidence of these extracurricular activities have also been uploaded (Cultural Event 1, Government Meeting 1, Volunteer Opportunity 1 and 2). While the numbers appear to demonstrate that African American students have equitable participation in extracurricular activities, the school will solicit feedback on this issue from the African American Student Council.

Results of Action

Taken:

IRCHS will continue its tradition of offering many extracurricular activities and requiring students to be engaged citizens.

Reflection:

IRCHS will work in tandem with the African American Student Council to ensure that all students have equitable access to extracurricular activities.
