Results of Action Taken:	The school does not offer competitive sports, but there are many thriving clubs on campus and extracurricular activities related to our courses in the arts. All faculty sponsors and arts teachers will participate in the professional development on culturally responsive best practices scheduled for 12/02/20. An African American Student Council was founded at the school on 10/08/20 and will submit feedback to administration on ways to improve African American participation in extracurricular activities.
Reflection:	Ultimately, most extracurricular activities flow through the arts programs offered at the school, so efforts to increase African American participation in extracurricular activities will be synonymous with efforts to increase African American enrollment in arts courses.
