The attached procedure represents the plan to ensure that extracurricular activities have a proportionate number of students within each subgroup, including African American students.

Results of Action Taken:

The only current extracurricular activities for students, due to COVID-19, is 5th grade safety patrols and Pirates on the Run. For fifth grade safety patrols, the percentages of students by ethnicity matched the total population of fifth grade students.

The multicultural coordinator will continue to monitor these percentages upon any changes in patrols during the year. Pirates on the Run is a flexible program and attendance varies greatly from day to day. The multicultural coordinator is working with the P.E. coach to ensure equity in this program and monitoring the attendance percentages compared to the ethnicity percentages in the total school population. Garden Club will be starting soon and the multicultural coordinator will work with the Garden Club staff to ensure equity in that program.

Reflection:

As the year progresses and we are able to add additional extracurricular activities, this procedure will ensure that students are equitably represented. Sometimes there are students that simply need an additional adult to encourage them to be involved beyond the regular classroom learning.

All extracurricular activities will submit student names and ethnicities to the school Multicultural Coordinator. The percentage of students in each subgroup, including African-American students, will be compared to schoolwide percentages. If the percentage of students are not within $5-10 \%$ of schoolwide percentages, students will be recruited to join the extracurricular activity.
