We will continue to learn more about data available in Power BI and pull this regularly to track student performance.


#### **Reflection:**

Teachers are more able to pull data and filter for specific subgroup data. We noticed teachers are becoming more aware of subgroup performance and can talk about specific student performance. Need additional training in Power BI tools and reports. Schedule progress monitoring for unit assessments in grades 3-5.




### Action Step 1.13 - Data Chats for Improved Student Learning
