Evidence of Progress Monitoring (Please include of the action taken. Where applicable, please include all measurable data.)

Leadership teams will provide supports to teachers using real- time data specific to African American students, to have effective data chats and planned targeted support for improved learning. Administrators and Instructional Coaches trained in Power BI will provide real-time narrative/description data specific to African American students to teachers. Department chairs will conduct data chats with teachers during department meeting to determine targeted supports for at risk students. Teachers will be trained in the use of Baseball Card, within Performance Matters to identify specific instructional needs for students and progress monitor the improved learning for those students.

Results of Action Taken:

Pre-School Planning Days- Administration trained on Power BI by Brian McMahon (Gonzalez, Morgan, Erickson, Ahrens, O'Keefe) 9/3/20- Instructional Coached trained on Power BI by Brian McMahon (Teachout, Hiller) 9/1/20- Department Chairs review goals of the SIP and compare achievement data used as the component for the school grade. 9/9/20 Department based professional development session focusing on the Baseball Card view of student specific data in Performance Matters. Specific data points will be reviewed for teacher progress monitoring and data chats. (Department Chairs providing training)

Reflection:

Monthly Monitoring- Leadership teams will meet with departments to conduct data chats specific to African- American students, using data from Power BI and the Baseball Card. Expected outcomes will be, planned support to target areas for growth and increase student achievement. Department Chair Meetings are held every first Tuesday of the month. Department Meetings are held every second Tuesday of the month. Individual data chats with teachers will include progress monitoring of African American students, including evidence of instructional strategies to support improved learning. Administration will meet with individual teachers using unit assessment data to progress monitor and develop

support plans for African American students that need additional support to master the standards assessed.
