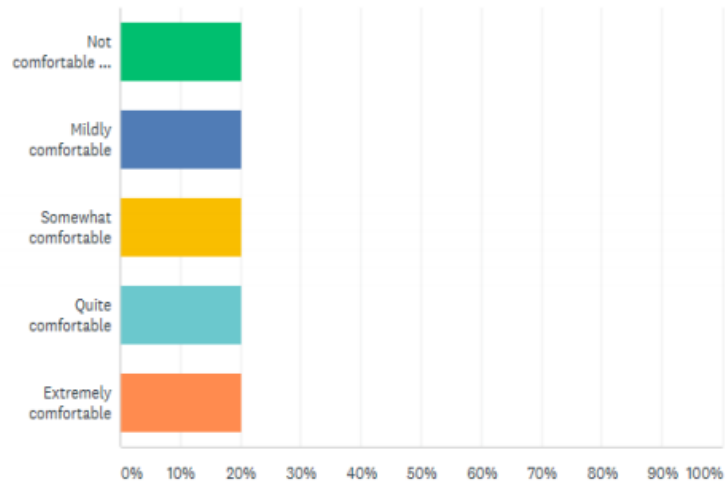


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How comfortable are you in asking for help from school adults?
