Explanation of Evidence:

African American students meet with the academic advisor monthly to discuss progress toward graduation requirements. Students who are not on track to graduate with their grade level peers are made aware of their options. Topics discussed include: credits earned, core course failures, FSA 10th Grade ELA results and FSA ALG 1 EOC results, attendance, course recovery progress on Edgenuity and any other relevant topics. Parents are notified and documentation is kept in Focus and on academic monitoring forms. Before and after school tutoring is being offered. Extended learning opportunities will be offered during the summer in the form of direct instruction and virtual instruction.

Results of Action Taken:

Students who are not meeting graduation requirements have been made aware of their options and are receiving the necessary support to earn their diploma. At the moment, none of the African American students have participated in before or after school tutoring.

Reflection:

The academic advisor will continue to meet with students and make them aware of their progress towards graduation. The school will continue to advertise and solicit participation in tutoring.
