**Explanation of Evidence:** Students meet with the academic advisor on a regular basis to discuss progress towards graduation. Topics include: graduation requirements, credits, courses needed, required assessments and post school planning. Meetings are recorded in Focus and on a school document. Parent contact is always attempted. After school tutoring is offered, as well as open computer lab during the summer to allow students an opportunity for course recovery.

**Results of Action Taken:** After meeting with the academic advisor, African American students and their parents are made aware of their progress toward obtaining a high school diploma. This allows students to adjust their academic pacing if necessary, and clears up any confusion they may have. They are able to receive answers to their specific questions. After school tutoring would be extremely beneficial to helping African American students receive extra assistance.

**Reflection:** Students report that they have a better understanding of their graduation track after meeting with the advisor. So far, no African American students have taken advantage of after school tutoring.


