<b>Explanation of Evidence:</b>	100% of students are currently enrolled in our course recovery credit program called Edgenunity. Each student has a course recovery class which gives them 1 to 3 hours a day in making up their course requirements. We have an Edgenunity instructor who manages and provides individualized direct instruction to all students during their blocked scheduled period.
<b>Results of Action Taken:</b>	The results of our actions have stressed the importance to our African-American students to graduate on time with their peers. Out of 23 African students 90% of them are actively participating on Edgenunity on a regular basis. The Edgenunity instructor has made contact with all face to face and virtual students on their progress as well as their parents on a weekly basis.
<b>Reflection:</b>	The course recovery program has proven to be a success for our African-American students as 100% of them are enrolled in our course recovery program. We are continuously trying to motivate the 10% of our African-American student population that remain stagnant as attendance issues and nonproductivity tends to hinder their progress.
