1.19 Collaborate with high school principals and graduation coaches to monitor and create an action plan to increase the achievement of identified students for course failures, concordant scores for ELA and Algebra 1, GPA, and advanced coursework.

**Explanation of
Evidence:**

In the Spring of 2019, every family of a student with one or more failing grades was called by administration. The school will continue that practice this year. Guidance Counselors, the Testing Coordinator, the Assistant Director, and the ESE Department meet weekly to discuss possibilities for students achieving concordant scores. The school coordinates with families to ensure students have the opportunity to take concordant tests when appropriate. Administration, guidance counselors, and the MTSS team look at a report of students who have failed the FSA ELA or FSA Algebra I Assessment (A.A. Students FSA Algebra I Achievement Level, A.A. Students FSA ELA Achievement Level). This team creates an action plan and reaches out to families. The school will continue its tradition of a SAT School Day, where all students who sign up can take the SAT at school and potentially earn a concordant score. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch can take the test for free. The school also offers the PSAT to all sophomore students, free of charge. PSAT scores can be utilized as a concordant score for the FSA Algebra I Assessment. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch can take this assessment at a reduced cost. The testing schedule which shows dates for 2020-2021 assessments has been uploaded (2020-2021 Testing Schedule). Students have independent study time built into their schedules. Peer tutoring will be available during this time.

**Results of Action
Taken:**

Guidance Counselors, Administration, and the MTSS team regularly reach out to families of African American students to make them aware of opportunities to take concordant tests when appropriate. All IRCHS students can, if they sign up, take the SAT or PSAT at school and potentially earn a concordant score.

Reflection:

Offering an 'SAT School Day' resulted in ninety juniors and seniors taking the SAT at school. 192 sophomores (nearly all) took the PSAT and some juniors took advantage of this opportunity as well. Some students achieved a concordant score through this process. The school will continue the tradition of administering the SAT and PSAT at school and seek out other opportunities for offering concordant score assessments.
