VBHS School Counselors will document quarterly meetings with African American students to discuss graduation needs. Principal will follow up with those students to check progress. Counselors currently meet quarterly with students who are not on track. • Guidance Counselors and Grad Coach work with students to walk through the registration process of the SAT/ACT and the PERT. Grad Coach keeps ACT/SAT binder for students in case they lose their admission ticket before testing days • Admin has set money aside to pay for SAT/ACT testing for students who have used up their waivers .Main Campus is currently meeting with seniors, FLC will start with Freshman 10/15-11/5 Based on credits and GPA 79.5% are on track to graduate at this time.

**Results of Action

By the middle of November 2020 all Option 1 seniors and Option 1 freshmen that are not on track, will have met with their counselor. Students will have a detailed outline of requirements needed to get back on track and a plan of action to meet their academic goals.
