Universal Screening Implementation Results

During the 19-20 school year, many students were screened for gifted, and there are 11 students in the gifted program (6/11 white, 4/11 Hispanic, 1/11 other). The School Counselor will continue this work during the 20-21 school year, starting with our 3rd narrative/descripti 5th graders. As of September 15, we have 7 students who will be tested based on i_ready reading results. Four are African American and 3 are Hispanic. Progress will be shared

with administration.

Results of Action Taken:

A timeline will be created to help ensure we successfully implement the procedures in the district plan and increase underrepresented populations in our gifted program, as we have reading buddies that different classrooms pair up together (ex. K and 5th) that will begin once COVID subsides.
