Provide tiered supports for enrichment to students in elementary schools that have low numbers of gifted identified students.

The Department of Instructional Innovation met with the ESE Department on September 4, 2020 to determine the criteria for which schools are considered "low number," based on past practice. Schools having less than 5 students identified as gifted will be the current practice. Attached is the list of schools that currently meet the criteria. Following the iReady diagnostic baseline, a criterion will be established to offer a new enrichment canvas course to students that meet requirements at each site.

Results of Action Taken: The online canvas enrichment course will now be offered each semester for students that meet the iReady criteria for reading/math enrichment.

Reflection: Evidence of opportunity will be captured through the canvas course.
