Power BI data reflecting Math and ELA regression for i-Ready and Unit Assessments as compared with Winter 2019-2020 and Fall 2020-2021.

**Results of Action Taken:**

Further data mining is necessary to “drill down” by grade level and subgroup to review regression of African American students who earned a level 3, 4 or 5 on a previous statewide assessment, which occurred 2 years ago, due to interruptions caused by the COVID pandemic closures.

**Reflection:**

There is an opportunity to make use of provisions of the Superintendent’s A2 Acclimate and Accelerate Plan to counteract regression that may be caused by the COVID pandemic interruptions.

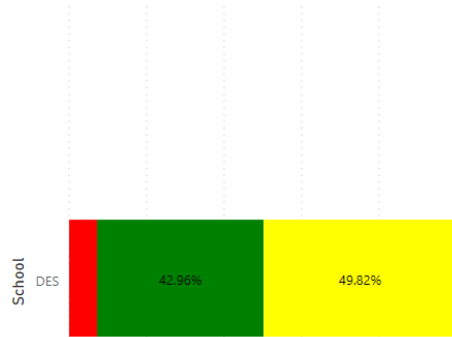

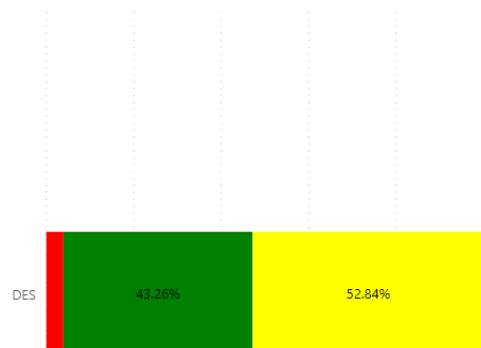
