This program uses our IB Unit of Inquiry, conceptual framework, and the learner profile traits to provide writing and ELA enrichment. The logistics of the program include the identified students in grades k-5 being provided participation in the program at least 3-4 days a week. The students will also be in regular collaboration with our IB Coordinator to identify any supports needed. Administration will also verify representation of our African American students in the program.

Taken:** Our expected results include deeper understanding of all components of IB. In addition, our students will increase their writing skills throughout the program.
