Explanation of Evidence:	This is a summary of the number of black students who participated in two opportunities offered this summer. The first page details the SRMS Summer Enrichment Program – the Principal's Challenge. The second page lists the number of black students who participated in the school district's Illuminate 2020 Enrichment program, which was a new offering, in which students were able to work on activities in all core areas and submit for weekly prizes. A letter explains the first opportunity which is provided every year by our teachers for students to get a jump-start on the material they will be learning about in class. The Principal's Challenge for ELA provides background information in the subjects students will be studying in the upcoming school year in Language Arts and Social Studies. In Math, the activities are designed to maintain students' skills. Additionally, students are expected to complete iReady Reading and Math lessons each week. In order to promote these activities, we posted notices on our social media accounts, and also posted the letter about Principal's Challenge on our website, and in FOCUS on the parent portal.
Results of Action Taken:	As a result of our efforts, 28 students participated in our Principal's Challenge, 5 of those students, or 22% of the total who participated, were black. For the Illuminate Summer Enrichment program, a larger percentage of our overall black population participated.
Reflection:	We will examine the types of assignments offered to our students in the Principal's Challenge and consider whether that may have an impact on student participation. If necessary, we will modify the Principal's

Challenge so it is more engaging for students.

Principal's Challenge – SRMS Summer Enrichment Program

Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

The 2020 Sebastian River Middle School's Principal's Reading and Math Challenges are now available on the SRMS Website. Our goal was to create Math and Reading activities that will provide your child with the necessary background knowledge in the subjects they will be studying in the next school year.

All SRMS students are *strongly encouraged* to complete the Principal's Reading and Math Challenge. <u>The Reading and Math Challenges will be due by Friday, August 21st, 2020.</u> Students completing the challenge will be rewarded for their efforts (past rewards have included bowling, a movie at AMC, pool party, etc.). To earn the Principal's Challenge Reward, students must complete the Reading and Math Challenges, and the i-Ready Reading and Math requirements.

READING CHALLENGE: The list of books provided is a *suggested* list. <u>If you can find a book at</u> <u>the library or bookstore that falls under the same type of category and is at grade level, that</u> <u>would be acceptable</u>. We understand that it may be difficult to find books in each child's reading level, but we believe that reading books from this list and completing the assignments will be beneficial for your child before they enter the 2020-21 school year. In addition to completing the Summer Reading Challenge activities, <u>students must complete at least one i-Ready Reading</u> <u>Lesson per week from June 8th to August 7th.</u>


MATH CHALLENGE: The activities that are assigned to your child are intended to keep their math skills sharp during summer break. Since our current 6^{th} and 7^{th} grade students will be scheduled to various math classes, your child's math teacher provided your child with the correct math packet at the end of the year. In addition to completing the Math Challenge packet, <u>students must complete</u> at least one i-Ready Math Lesson per week from June 8th to August 7th.
