**Results of Action
Taken:** The Student Services team will meet again the week of September 28th to further outline how interventions highlighted in the 2020-2021 SDIRC Code of Student Conduct are used as alternatives to suspension and other exclusionary practices. Additionally, the team will conduct a needs assessment in fall 2020 related to alternatives to suspension to evaluate how schools are using currently available interventions what type of additional interventions or programming may be needed to support students in SDIRC.

Reflection: The Student Services team will continue to make data-driven recommendations and promote evidence-based and -informed alternatives to suspension interventions.
