
**Evidence of Progress Monitoring** (Please include of the action taken. Where applicable, please include all measurable data.)

In-school suspensions are not utilized at Indian River Academy at this point in the year; narrative/description instead, detentions, "Time Outs" or other are utilized in order to maximize time in class for instructional learning.
