2.10 District will work with schools to conduct a review of In-School Suspension programs and support school's development of actions to improve outcomes. IRCHS students does not suspend students, but a record of demerits (referrals) issued to African American students was generated. So far this year, three African American students have received demerits (A.A. Students with Demerits 2020-2021).

Explanation of Evidence: Students who attend IRCHS sign a behavior contract, which obligates them to positive and productive behavior. At IRCHS, all students who violate the behavior contract receive demerits. A copy of the demerit is mailed home, and administration often calls to follow up.

Results of Action Taken: IRCHS does not suspend students. The philosophy of the school is that out-of-school and in-school suspensions rob students of valuable instructional time. The school will strive to have equity in disciplinary practices for African American students.

Reflection: Currently, the school offers students the chance to have a certain number of demerits forgiven by giving back to the school during student independent study time. IRCHS seeks to expand these opportunities and reduce the number of demerits given.
