Explanation of Evidence:

At this time, Vero Beach Elementary as it relates to all students has not begun due to the current reality of COVID-19. At this time, we are recruiting 5th grade students to mentor students in grades K-3. Accompanying this cover sheet is the application for 5th grade students. Once submitted, the school counselor and administrators will pair students together. Our current date goal for starting this mentorship is December 7, 2020. In addition to peer to peer mentoring with our campus, the below steps are being planned for and will be implemented in the 2nd semester.

1. VBHS students will mentor certain AA students who are facing challenges. This will begin in the 2nd semester. We have reached out to Carrie Adams, coordinator of the mentors at VBHS and she has shared that high school students have not yet been recruited for the program.
2. Bottom quartile students have been paired with administrators or the school counselor to provide one on one mentoring around academics and behavior.
3. We have partnered some of our AA employees with AA students as mentors.

Results of Action Taken:

VBE will continue working on establishing a peer to peer program to start in December.
