SDIRC continues to fine-tune recruiting strategies for the 2020-2021 school year. Relationships to HBCUs and the scheduling the spring SDIRC Virtual Career Fair will bring more eligible candidates to Indian River County.

The Department of HR will continue to monitor the pool of applicants, invitations to interview, and offers for employment. The Department of Recruitment and Retention is building relationships and monitoring feedback from focus groups to tailor recruiting strategies to African American candidates.
