> pursue a degree other than what they already hold. School leadership has moved to add an additional layer to this goal by focusing on placing AA teachers and VBE staff in positions of leadership. Currently, we have 66% of our instructional coaching staff who are AA. C=In our

current leadership roles, 64% are white, 21% or AA/Black, and 14% are Hispanic.
