In August 2021, the School District of Indian River County initiated the implementation of the 2021-2022 African American Achievement Plan. - Progress related to the elimination of the achievement gap has been monitored in an ongoing way and needed modifications have been made as identified.

At the beginning of the school year we asked our school administrator teams to identify a list of extracurricular activities offered on their campus, provide a brief description of extracurricular, and select photos to highlight student participation in extracurriculars. Additionally, The Champions List will support the district's compliance with F.S. 1014.05 (e) Procedures, pursuant to s. 1006.195(1)(a), for a parent to learn about the nature and purpose of clubs and activities offered at his or her minor child's school, including those that are extracurricular or part of the school curriculum.

As a gentle reminder, section 1006.15(2), Florida Statutes, defines extracurricular activities as *"any school-authorized or education-related activity occurring during or outside the regular instructional school day;"*

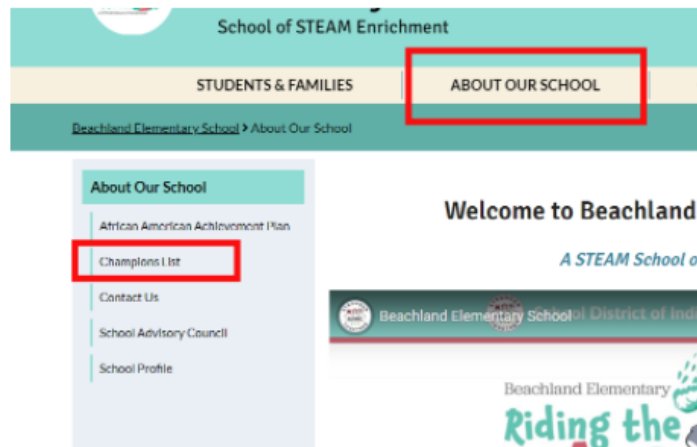


Families, have you heard of the SDIRC Champions List?

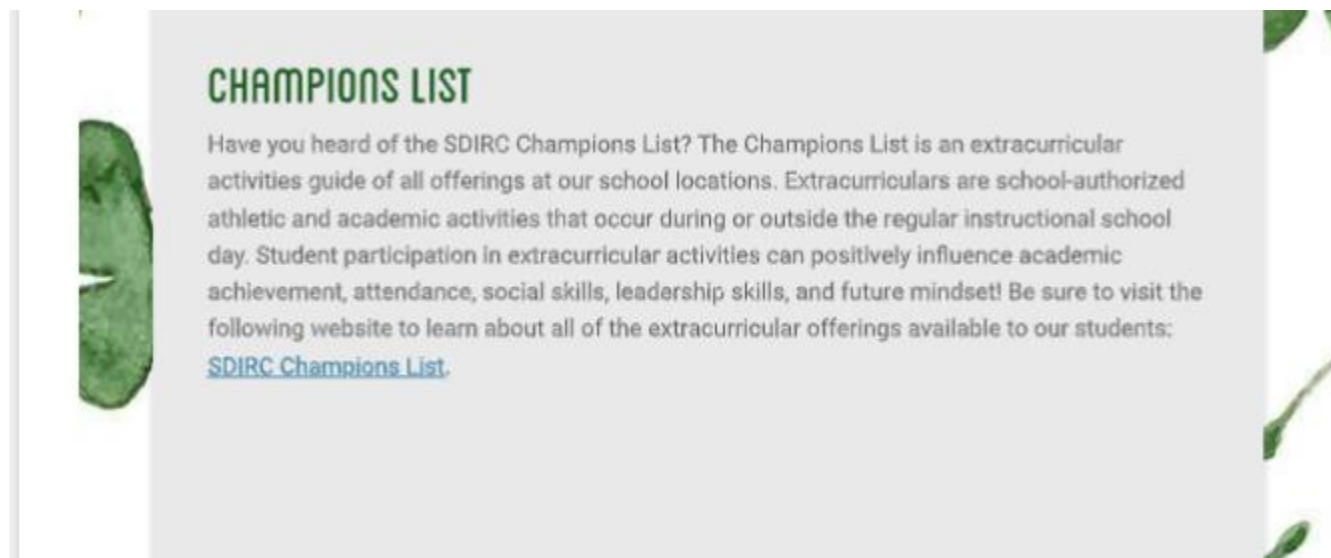
