In September 2022, the School District of Indian River County initiated the implementation of the 2022-2023 African American Achievement Plan. With support of the SDIRC Public Information Office we have pushed out a new school choice video for each school on our social media platforms from the Indian River County handle on facebook and twitter. These videos also play on loop on our education channel for Indian River County. In addition, we have continued with the family and community engagement series events hitting schools that have been historically low in school choice enrollment including Glendale, Dodgertown, and Sebastian Elementary. The innovation team has also joined with the Moonshot Community Action network to spread information across our non-profit and community support organizations about our school choice program open enrollment window that began on November 1st, 2022, and will continue until January 15th 2023.

In addition to the digital platform, the innovation team has distributed a total of 500 printed school choice booklets throughout Indian River County utilizing our pre-k partnerships and our early learning program supervisors. We have also placed booklets in non-traditional locations including local barber shops, church lobbies, the DMV, pediatric dentists, and pediatric doctor's offices.

October 26, 2022	Moonshot Community Action Network, Non-profit support. Printed school choice booklets were distributed to over 25 non-profit and community organizations to continue sharing about the open enrollment window and school choice offerings.
October 26, 2022	Pre-K outreach. Working with District Pre-K, Head Start, Early Learning Coalition, and local daycares, the innovation team distributed over 200 school choice printed booklets for families in preparation for the November 1, 2022, enrollment window opening.

November 1, 2022	SDIRC Community Liaison and Innovation team distributed over 200 books across Indian River County.
December 5, 2022	Weekly School Choice Video Smore Push out. Each week the Instructional Innovation team will be pushing out the School Choice Video links, along with information for the enrollment window.
December 7, 2022	SDIRC school choice booklet distribution at the State of the District Event to local non-profit supports.
