AFRICAN AMERICAN ACHIEVEMENT PLAN

The African American Achievement Plan was initially discussed at a School Board Workshop on February 11, 2020. The School Board of Indian River County approved the African American Achievement Plan on February 25, 2020. The plan included an African American Achievement Progress Report Card which denotes progress measures that will be monitored throughout the year. The report card data is updated monthly to ensure consistent implementation and monitoring of action steps as outlined in the African American Achievement Plan.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR IMPROVEMENT

- Academic Performance (~10-20% Achievement Gap depending on subject)
- Kindergarten Readiness (64% White, 43% Black/AA)
- Graduation Rate (92% White, 81% Black/AA)
- Office Discipline Referrals (12% White, 25% Black/AA)
- Suspensions (ISS: 3% White, 6% Black/AA; OSS: 3% White, 8% Black/AA)
- ACE Enrollment (34% White, 47% Black/AA)
- Teacher Demographics (88.7% White, 9.9% Black/AA)

IMPACT OF COVID-19

- Impact to AAA plan
 - No academic outcome measures for the school year
 - No longer monitoring Discipline and ESE data
 - No end of year data chats at the school or district level
- How will this impact plan moving forward
 - Continue to monitor i-Ready and Achieve 3000 usage and data
 - Moving Full Steam Ahead:
 - Review of Master School schedules
 - Review of Discipline plans
 - Update Student Progression Plan
 - Update Recruitment Plan
 - Creation of a plan to monitor graduation
 - Develop a Plan PD on culturally responsive instructional practices
