

## ROSEWOOD MAGNET "PANTHER PERFORMERS" CHORUS GUIDELINES

The success of the Rosewood Magnet Chorus is dependent upon the dedication of its members. The chorus will be everything that its members wish it to be. Dedicated chorus members are:

- 1) Good citizens who follow school rules.
- 2) Respectful, Responsible, Ready to learn and make safe choices
- 3) Good musicians who keep up with their musical knowledge and continue to learn.
- 4) Good students who keep up with their homework and classroom responsibilities.

In order for this chorus experience to be the best for everyone involved, the following guidelines will be enforced. Please know that failure to comply with any of the guidelines will result in dismissal from chorus.

1. Members must attend and be on time for all rehearsals and performances.
  - a. Any absences must be accompanied by a signed note from the parent unless student is absent from school on day of rehearsal.
  - b. Rehearsal: Wednesday and Fridays from 8:10-8:40am.
  - c. Non-chorus members including siblings are not permitted in the music room during chorus rehearsals.
  - d. Special Rehearsals: Extra rehearsals may be needed and will be announced prior to the time.
2. Members will not eat or drink during rehearsals. (**Chorus members must eat the school breakfast before coming to chorus or eat breakfast at home**). They will not be able to eat breakfast after the rehearsal.)
3. Members must do their best to learn their part when asked to do so.
4. Members will wear appropriate clothing (school uniform) for performances. **Boys wear white shirts and long navy pants.** Girls wear white Peter Pan blouses or white polo shirt and navy skirt or skort. Girls may also wear the Rosewood Plaid skirt, skort, or jumper. Ties will be provided. **NO OPEN TOED SHOES OR FLIP FLOPS!**
5. Members will exhibit excellent behavior during rehearsals and performances. A quiet atmosphere must be present to hear music and instructions. Any student misbehaving during a rehearsal will be sent back to their classroom. More than three incidences will result in a student being removed from chorus membership.
6. Transportation to and from rehearsals and performances is the responsibility of students and parents.
