Description of Program

SNAG Golf (Starting here in Golf) is a non-fee based and "free lunch" program to introduce golf to those new to the game. Activities follow the guide of TRG Training - Practice - Competition. Tournament includes two clubs (Sunshine and Storm) and teams play both club and team to score lowest targets. SNAG Golf equipment is playground and permission only.

Objective of the Program

The objective is to introduce students to all aspects of the game of golf including fundamentals of the golf swing, safety, playing to the rules, how to play the game while teaching the skills and game etiquette based upon individual focus and instruction. Students will transition from SNAG Golf equipment to advance using TRADITION Golf equipment.

Location: On campus with back-up arrangements in the event of inclement weather

Times: After School during the school week (10:30 a.m. to 6:45 p.m.)
