VBHS Graduation Warning Signs

Vero Beach High School Guidance Counselors and Graduation Coach monitor the Early Warning Signs at both progress reports and every nine weeks, at a minimum eight times a school year. Counselors meet with students, send letters home, and call home to discuss failing grades, attendance and testing issues that might prevent a student from graduating on time. When necessary, counselors refer students to other resources at the school to provide additional support, e.g. outside counseling. Counselors also provide information regarding credit recovery options during and after school. The Graduation Coach reviews testing requirements with students and find opportunities for students to earn concordant scores. This includes helping students that qualify sign up for free SAT and ACT opportunities, as well as referring them to test prep strategies for said tests.
