1.19 - Ensure African American students who have not met course requirements for graduation are participating in "in-school" credit recovery classes to recover failed core courses and raise grade point averages to meet graduation requirements

Narrative

At SRMS we have students working to recover courses using Edgenuity. These students are monitored daily by the In-School Suspension Teacher and weekly by the 8th Grade School Counselor. Students and parents are contacted to ensure initial enrollment and are aided as they progress. A period in their schedule is dedicated to working on course recovery. Administration is provided with a weekly report of student completion rate and days since last login. Less than 10 black students are currently enrolled in credit recovery courses.

Data

Students currently enrolled in Edgenuity:

Action Plan

We will continue to monitor these students weekly and contact them at least once a week, providing them with assistance as needed. School counselor will encourage regular, continued progress and school will recognize successful completion of courses.
