

VBHS Quarterly Guidance Graduation Meetings

- 1.26 Implement a plan that requires every school counselor to meet quarterly with at-risk African American students to discuss graduation needs. The principal will meet with students to determine the impact of graduation support.

Narrative

Counselors meet and address the graduation needs of all students at least quarterly. Guidance director pulls reports that show progress towards graduation status. Students that are at risk will be called down and success plans created. Plans will be monitored by the counselor and graduation coach.

Action Plan

Once a calendar is board approved and graduation dates set, we will provide a list of our meetings which will include quarterly meetings with African American students to discuss graduation needs. Data will be kept on how many African American meetings are held per counselor.
