Due to the efforts of the Positive Learning Environment Committee, our Behavioral Specialist, and collaboration with teachers, staff, and administration, out of school suspensions have drastically decreased since October 2019. In an effort to support the social-emotional learning of our students, different services and interventions have been put in place to target students' needs including parent shadowing, restorative practices, conflict resolution, check-in/check-out, social skills groups, anger management groups, and mental health referrals/counseling.
