

2.6 Complete and implement interventions outlined in school behavior plans to eliminate Out-of-School Suspensions.

## **Implementation Steps:**

- Teachers will develop and submit their Classroom Management Plans.
- 2. Teachers must include Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) expectations in their Classroom Management Plans.
- 3. Teachers will submit a copy of their Classroom Management Plans to Assistant Principal for approval.
- Teachers must implement their Classroom Management Plans as a manifestation of Tier 1 Behavior Expectations.
- 5. Teachers will post **school-wide** Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) expectations.
- Teachers will post classroom Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) expectations.
- For students with persistent, undesired behaviors that do not respond to Tier 1 Behavior protocols, teachers will refer these students to the MTSS School-Based Team (SBT) for collective problem-solving and possible referral to Tier 2 Behavior Interventions.
- Teachers must implement the Tier 1 and Tier 2 behavior interventions with fidelity (monitor and adjust, as needed).
- 9. Complete and implement interventions outlined in school behavior plans to eliminate **Outof-School Suspensions (OSS).**
